The venue will be Marina di Ravenna, Ravenna, Italy from 12th to May 15th 2016.

EVENT GRADING

The event is an ISAF Grade 3 event. However, this grading is subject to review by the ISAF Match Race Advisory Board. The event may be re-graded when there is clear reason to do so.

THE PROVISIONAL PROGRAMME

- (a) Race office opens from 09.00 hrs May 12th 2016.
- (b) Registration will be on May 12th 2016 from 09.00a.m. to 18.00 and on May 13th 2016 from 08.30 a.m. to 09.00 a.m.
- (c) Crew weighting will be on May 12th 2016 from 09.00a.m to 18.00
- (d) The pratice race (after the registration) will be on May 12th 2016 from 09.30a.m. to 12.30 and from 14.00 to 18.00 (2 hrs per team, mandatory booked).
- (e) The first briefing with the umpires will be on May 13th 2016 at 09.15 a.m.
- (f) Racing days will be from May 13th to May 15th 2016.
- (g) The time of the first attention signal for the first day will be May 13th 2016 at 10.30 a.m.
- (h) The latest time for an attention signal on the last day of racing will be 5.00 p.m.

Unless excused by the organising authority, attendance at the following is mandatory:

- (a) The daily first briefing, for skippers.
- (b) The prize giving from the final skippers and crews.

SKIPPER ELIGIBILITY

- (a) Ten skippers will be invited. Only the skippers invited by the Organising Authority will be eligible to enter this event.
- (b) The designated skipper shall helm the yacht at all times while racing, except in an emergency.
- (c) A skipper shall confirm acceptance of invitation in writing (fax or e-mail is acceptable) and pay the fee by the date specified on the letter of invitation.
- (d) To remain eligible the entire crew shall complete registration, pay the initial damage deposit of € 500.= and complete crew weighting before sailing the boats.

















(e) All competitors shall meet the eligibility requirements of ISAF regulations.

ENTRIES

The skipper shall be entered on complation of registration, crew weighting and payment of all fees and deposits.

ENTRIES

A non-refundable entry fee of €.300.= shall be paid

- in cash
- by bank transfer to bank

When a skipper accepts an invitation and later withdraws within 30 days of the event or leaves the event before the end without a written approval from the O.A., a zero score may be applied to their Ranking point for the event by the ISAF (ISAF Regulation 27.2)

DAMAGE DEPOSIT

- (a) An initial damage deposit of €.500.= shall be paid at registration, unless extented by the O.A. This deposit is the the maximum payable by the skipper as a result of any one incident.
- (b) In the event of a deduction from the damage deposit is decided by the organising authority it may require that the deposit be restored to its original amount before the skipper will be permitted to continue in the event.
- (c) Any remaining deposit after the event will be resumed.

All competitors shall obtain an ISAF Sailor ID by registering online at www.sailing.org/isafsailor.

RULES

The following rules shall govern the event:

- (a) The current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), including Appendix C.
- (b) MNA Prescriptions will not apply
- (c) The sailing instructions (available at registration) and any amendments.
- (d) The rules for the handling of boats, which shall also apply to any practice sailing.
- (e) Major alterations to the RRS
- 1. Add to RRS 41: Help to recover from the water and return on board a crew member, provided the return on board is at the approximative location of the recovery
- 2. RRS C8.6 and C6.3 will be changed in the sailing instructions

A protest Committe (PC) will be appointed by the National Authority. The right of appeal will be denied with RRS 70.5.

BOATS & SAILS

- (a) The event will be sailed in Tom 28'.
- (b) Six (6) boats will be provided.
- (c) The following sails will be provided for each boat. Mainsail, Jib, Spinnaker.
- (d) Boats will be allocated by draw, either daily or for each round as decided by the R.O.

CREW (including skipper).

- (a) The number of crew (including the skipper) shall be (4), in case of full female team the number od component will be 5 (five) plus one possible reserve. All registered crew shall sail all races.
- (b) The maximum total crew weight, determined prior to racing shall be 350 Kg, when wearing at least shorts and shirts; 340 kg in case of full female crew.
- (c) When a registered skipper is unable to continue in the event the Organising Authority may authorise an original crew member to substitute.

















(d) When a registered crew member is unable to continue in the event the organising authority may authorise a substitute, a temporary substitute or other adjustment.

EVENT FORMAT

The event will consist in the following Stage.

- a) The ten (10) skippers will sail a complete round robin (each skipper sails each other skippers once).
- b) Semifinals and finals.
- c) The O.A. may change the format, terminate or eliminate any round, when conditions do not permit the complation of the intended format.

COURSE

- (a) The course will be windward/leeward with starboard rounding finishing downwind.
- (b) The intended course area will be inside the breakwaters, or outside those, as per decision of the Harbour Authority.

ADVERTISING

- (a) As boats and equipment will be supplied by the O.A., ISAF Regulation 20.4 applies. Each boat will be required to display advertising as supplied by the A.O. Competitors will be required to wear clothing of an event sponsor while racing and at official function.
- (b) Competitors may be permitted to display advertising ashore at the venue, but is subject to individual negotiation with the O.A.
- (c) The right to protest boat vs.boat is denied for alleged infringements of any rules regarding advertising (This amends RRS 60.1).

PRIZES

The "Memorial Sabrina Gurioli" Trophy Challenge will be awarded to the winner.

Prizes for 1st,2nd and 3rd placed skippers.

The prize giving ceremony will be at Hospitality Point of Circolo Velico Ravennate as soon as possible after the end of the races.

COACH BOATS

Coacht boats shall conspicously display identification of the team being coached.

The O.A. will provide berths for coach boats.

Any interference by a coach with the racing or event organisation may result in a penalty applied at the discrection of the P.C. to the appropriate skipper or team.

MEDIA, IMAGES AND SOUND

The organising authority may require competitors to be available for interviews. The O.A. shall be have the right to use any images and sounds reordered during the event free of any charge.

All those taking part in the event do so at their own risk. The Organizing Committee, their associates and appointees, the P.R.O., the umpires, the Race Committee all the sponsors and supporters accept no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury or inconvenience incurred, howsoever caused occurred to persons and things, both ashore and at sea, as consequence of participation in any way in the event covered by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.
